Devontae Booker	Utah	Utah State	44	29	9500	9200	31	Booker is only in play on DK. I prefer the backs above, but Booker is still quality enough that if you need the extra \$\$\$, and you very well may, Booker can be played with confidence.
Joseph Yearby	Miami (Florida)	Florida Atlantic	55	36	6600	8200	107	It's hard to say what the volume will look like, but Miami should be able to run all over FAU.
